

MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

BY-LAW NO. 47

A by-law to borrow the sum of Seventh-five thousand dollars on the credit of the district.

The trustees of MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:


1. It shall be lawful for the trustees to borrow the sum of **Seventy-five thousand** dollars (\$ **75000.00**) or any smaller sum from **Bank of Montreal, Nanaimo** and to pledge the toll collecting and taxing powers of the district for the repayment of the said sum.
2. It shall be lawful for the trustees to issue promissory notes obligating the district to repay the sum so borrowed and to pay interest thereon at the prime rate per annum in effect, plus no more than one-half percentum per annum thereon.
3. The sum so borrowed shall be repaid on or before the **31st** day of **December**, 19**87**.
4. This by-law may be cited as the "**Fire truck purchase** Loan By-law".
