MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

BY-LAW No. 8.

A By-law for levying taxes on the land and improvements in the District for street lights and fire protection purposes.


The Trustees of "The Mountain Fire Protection District" enact as follows:

1. The sum of One Thousand Dollars is required by the District for fire protection and street lighting purposes for the year 1959.
2. The basis of assessment for levying taxes to raise the said sum shall be the values of the land and improvements hereinafter mentioned.
3. A tax at such rate as may be determined by the Provincial Assessor for the Nanaimo Assessment District to be necessary to raise the aforesaid sum, is hereby levied for the year 1959 on all land and improvements, as defined in the School Act, within the district as shown in the current Provincial Assessment roll.
4. The said taxes shall be due on the second day of July, 1959, and if they remain unpaid on the 31st day of October 1959, they shall be deemed delinquent on that day and thereafter shall bear interest at the rate of four and one-half per centum per annum until paid or removed.

5. This By-law may be cited as the "Taxation Bylaw, 1959".

INTRODUCED and given a first reading by the Trustees the second day of October, 1958.

RECONSIDERED and FINALLY PASSED, by the Trustees the 22nd day of October, 1958.


