

Criminal Record Check

Criminal Record Checks (CRC) are required for all individuals who volunteer with the Mountain Fire Protection District (MFPD) and as required by the provincial government under the Criminal Records Review Act.

The volunteer will be responsible for providing a current CRC. If the volunteer has a current CRC they may provide that.

The CRC will be kept by the Chairperson of the MFPD.

All volunteers are subject to a CRC every five years.

A volunteer will go the local RCMP detachment and fill out a **CONSENT TO A CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK** and will be responsible for the payment of the request.

In Part 2 of the form:

1. The organization name is **MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.**
2. the Organization contact name or title is the **CHAIR PERSON OF THE MOUNTAIN FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT.**

Once the volunteer has the form returned they will give it to the Chair Person of the Mountain Fire Protection District who will review the form. Should there be a violation the Chair Person will ask for further clarification.

The Volunteer will be reimbursed for the payment of the Criminal Record Check upon providing a receipt.
